Jewellery/ False Nails

NO jewellery or false nails are to be worn at all in school except for stud earrings and a watch in KS2. False nails make it difficult for children to write and use all the learning resources and is also a health and safety concern

There are to be NO SMART watches in school as these can be used to record and take photographs and this is a safeguarding concern

No earrings are to be worn for PE – this is a health and safety issue and is a Halton rule. Please remove your child's earrings before they come into school on the days they have PE, as Staff are not allowed to remove or put earrings in for pupils. Newly pierced ears or earrings that cannot be removed for medical reasons (please speak to staff at school if this is the case) must be covered by plasters which staff will NOT put on, so please do this at home before they come into school.

Attendance

Our school attendance is becoming worryingly low again. Almost half of our pupils have attendance over 95% which means that half have very poor attendance which is bringing the whole school attendance down. I will be making phone calls to the parents of all pupils with below 90% attendance at some point this month.

Last week whole school attendance was 89.1% which is a long way off our target.
