REMINDERS

Reception parents please pay snack fund on the school gateway app

Pupils in Year 3 and above now need to pay for school meals unless you have applied for and been told you are eligible for free school meals.

Water bottles are for plain water ONLY. Please do not send juice in water bottles.

Healthy Packed lunches only please. We are seeing lunches already that have too much food for the children to eat in one meal and boxes filled with chocolate. We will send out information with advice on healthy packed lunches.

No jewellery other than ear studs which should be removed on PE days. No make up is to be worn in school – this includes false nails and nail varnish.

Flu immunisations are coming up in October. It is administered in the form of a nasal spray and is completely painless. I would highly recommend that you agree to your child having the vaccination.

School Trips

Winmarleigh Hall

If your child is going to Winmarleigh hall on the Year 5/6 residential next year, please make sure that you are up to date with your payments. If we cannot make payments on time it may result in the trip being cancelled.

- A deposit of at least £50 is payable by FRIDAY 14th JULY 2023 (non-returnable).
- A further £50 will need to be paid by FRIDAY 29th SEPTEMBER 2023.
- The remaining balance of £90 will need to be paid by FRIDAY 5th JANUARY 2024.


