Are You an Attendance 'HERO'?

It is vital that we work together to encourage regular attendance and punctuality in school; this will ensure that we are able to give all our pupils the best possible education. The school introduced a whole class incentive to promote good attendance last academic year and this is continuing. Each week, staff will look to see which of our four classes has attendance above **96%**; when this is achieved the class receives a series of letters which spell out 'HERO'. Once all four letters have been awarded, the class will receive a non-uniform day. Classes 3 and 4 received their first letters last week, while Class 1 have also achieved the letter 'H' today.
