It seems strange to be writing the newsletter on a Monday but it's good to be looking ahead to another exciting week in school. Classrooms are busy this morning and the school is full of happy smiling faces. It will be great to see you all in school on Wednesday morning for our first coffee morning of the year. Attendance

Thank you all for your continued support for our Attendance focus. Unfortunately we have seen a significant dip in attendance and our attendance for last week was 87.8%. We already have 40 pupils across the school with less than 95% attendance after a month in school and 32 children with less than 90% attendance. No classes will receive a Halebank Attendance Star today. I know that your child's learning is important to you so could please ensure that they are in school unless they are sick. Reminders will be going home today to individual families where attendance is below target and there will be congratulations and thank you messages going home on Friday to all those who have managed 95% or above.

Punctuality is also a focus for us in school as lateness has a direct impact on learning. Punctuality reminders will be sent out today to anyone who has been late on more than two occasions in September. Can I just remind you that if your child arrives at school after 9.30am then an unauthorised absence will be registered for that session.

Willow class have won the award for tidiest classroom this week and have shown us how much they respect the equipment and resources available to them and that they are willing to tidy up after themselves and work as a team.
