Dear Parents and Carers.

I COULD NOT BE PROUDER OF OUR WHOLE SCHOOL COMMUNITY THIS WEEK. As you know OFSTED have visited the school this week and have been talking to staff, parents, governors and pupils. All stakeholders have shared their experiences of life and learning at Halebank and our visitors could clearly see how much we work together to improve outcomes for pupils and how far we have already come on our journey towards our vision. Thank you all for your engagement in the inspection process; completing questionnaires and stopping for a chat on the playground. Our children were as polite and well behaved as always and they were proud to talk about the school. Staff and Governors were amazingly supportive in their roles. I could not have done this without them.

Attendance

Thank you to you all for continuing to support the school in our attempts to improve attendance and learning opportunities for all our pupils.

Last week's whole school attendance was 95%

Whole school attendance for this half term is 92.5% even with lots of sickness bugs affecting school over the last few weeks.

Individual attendance letters will be sent out in the first week after half term. In most cases these will be information sharing letters about your child's attendance to keep you abreast of percentages and missed learning. Some however may be asking you to come into school to discuss your personal circumstances to see if we can support you. This will happen if your child's attendance at school has deteriorated. Some of you will be receiving Certificates to celebrate 95% and above attendance.
